Routed Export POA-FPPI Cover Letter

Foreign Principal Party in Interest Routed Export Transaction Power of Attorney (POA)

In order to file the required electronic export declaration (AES) information for “foreign consignee routed” US Export shipments, L.E. Coppersmith, Inc. must have authorization from the Foreign Principal Party in Interest (FPPI). This authorization, can be in the form of a Customs or Export Power of Attorney (POA), or an EEI Authorization form.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau’s Foreign Trade Regulations 15 CFR 30.3 (e)(2), the forwarder and/or authorized agent is responsible to:

1. Obtain a POA or written authorization from the Foreign Principal Party in Interest (FPPI) to prepare and file the Electronic Export Information (EEI) via the Automated Export System (AES) on their behalf.
2. Prepare and file the EEI based on information obtained from the United States Principal Party in Interest (USPPI) or other parties involved in the transaction.
